



Millborn's South Dakota Special Turf Mix

Description

Millborn's South Dakota Turf Mix was designed to handle the drought and wind of the prairie, while providing an alternative low maintenance turf.

Uses

Great for seeding tough areas of low fertility on the Great Plains.

When to Plant

Spring: April - June
Fall: Late August
Dormant: November – Freeze Up

Recommended Seeding Rate

130 lbs/acre

Components

25% Blue Grama
5% Buffalograss
20% Hard Fescue
25% Chewings Fescue
10% Sheeps Fescue
12% Annual Ryegrass
3% Alkaligrass

Availability

25 lb bags

Seeding Guidelines

- It is desirable to have at least 6" of black topsoil.
- If weeds are a problem, apply a glyphosate herbicide (Roundup®) and allow weeds to burn down for at least 7 days.
- Remove rocks and other debris. Till the top 4"-6" of soil. Add compost or additional soil at this time. Till one more time.
- Firm up the seedbed by dragging and/or roll packing. When walked on, you should not sink more than 1".
- For spring seedings, it's best to plant from April through early June. For fall seedings, plant between late August and early September.
- Seed with a special grass drill.
- Apply 24-5-10 Fertilizer 50% SCU with Prospect® at 150 lbs per acre.
