# TECH SHEET

## BIG BLUESTEM

As a perennial warm-season grass, Big Bluestem is a versatile option for wildlife, conservation and forage use. The blue coloration on the stem and purple flower clusters makes this grass stand out among the rest. Big Bluestem can be found in several areas from open prairies and roadsides to sandy areas and along riverbanks.

### AGRONOMICS

Varieties	Bison, Bonilla, Sunnyview, Pawnee, MN Native
Mature Height	4-8 feet
Soil Moisture	Medium to Dry
Seeding Rate	8 lbs/acre
Package	1 lb bag, 10 lb bag, 50 lb bag
Planting Instructions	Site preparation is vital for allowing your seed to make clean contact with the soil, allowing for successful and uniform germination. Start with a clean, firm, weed-free seedbed to allow for uniform seed placement and an increased chance for faster establishment.
