BUFFALOGRASS

Buffalograss is a warm-season perennial that reaches a height of 4" to 6" when mature. Primarily used for landscaping, erosion control and livestock and wildlife grazing. Buffalograss can be found growing on prairies and pastures with clay or alkaline soils.
