COMMON ALFALFA

We are a South Dakota based company and this is common, South Dakota harvested alfalfa seed. It comes from the western part of our state and therefore will have good drought tolerance and winter hardiness. Economical alfalfa seed with good longevity for a range of uses.

Seeding Rate	Good Soil, Adequate Moisture: 15-20 lbs/acre Light Soil, Dry Conditions: 12-15 lbs/acre
Seeding Depth	1/2 inch
