COMMON MILKWEED

Common Milkweed provides necessary protection and habitat to butterflies. As a perennial forb, this milkweed grows well in sandy, clay, or rocky soils along waterways in a number of environments. Common Milkweed grows flowers ranging from a rose pink to purple color.

Light Requirements	Full, Partial
Bloom Period	May-August
Bloom Color	Pink
Mature Height	3 feet
Soil Moisture	Medium to Dry
Seeding Rate	15-20 lbs/acre
Package	1 lb, 5 lb
Planting Instructions	Site preparation is vital for allowing your seed to make clean contact with the soil, allowing for successful and uniform germination. Start with a clean, firm, weed-free seedbed to allow for uniform seed placement and an increased chance for faster establishment.
