## COWPEAS

Cowpeas are a warm season legume commonly used as a canning crop or cover crop. Cowpeas possess very good abilities to fix nitrogen, and create quick decomposing residue. They like heat to ensure they grow fast. Cowpeas are a great species to include in a cover crop blend being planted in the heat of the summer.
