Conventional Forage Sorghum is a warm season annual sorghum planted for the intent for grazing or chopping for silage. With a maximum height of 8-23 feet tall, it possesses very high yield potential. This is a great option for a high yielding replacement to corn silage. Whether you are looking for a higher protein source of silage or a non-host for corn root worms, Forage Sorghum is a great option to put into any feed ration.
