WILD BERGAMOT

Wild Bergamot is a fragrant perennial used for flower arrangements and pollinator attraction. This flower grows well in nurseries and several neutral soil types. Wild Bergamot can grow to be 20" to 4' tall with distinct gray to green leaves and pink to lavender-colored petals.
