# TECH SHEET

## WINTER CAMELINA

Winter Camelina is the only winter annual brassica on the market. It is currently being researched for a possible oilseed crop, but currently being used mainly as a cover crop. Most all winter hardy cover crop species are grass with a fibrous root structure, adding a brassica to the mix will add diversity to the soil profile assisting in water infiltration and reducing in soil erosion.
